

**1969** was a landmark year for social activism. The Stonewall Riots, the anti-Vietnam War protests, the rise of the Chicano and women's liberation movements, the Native American occupation of Alcatraz, and the emergence of environmental activism all contributed to movements for civil rights, peace, and gender equality. In 1969, my mom, Linda, left her job at the UAW in Windsor at age 18 and moved to Toronto to help draft dodgers fleeing the Vietnam War. Her commitment to social justice, human rights, and peace echoed the ideals that inspired the musicians of that era. My mentor and dear friend, David Clayton-Thomas of Blood, Sweat & Tears, played Woodstock and now often reflects on a time when musicians were not just artists but warriors for social justice and peace. Today, David expresses frustration with global affairs, and my mom remains hopeful for the efforts of future generations. A huge thank you to my inspirators: DCT, my mom and all the social activists who continue to inspire us today. My hope for this album is that the music will bring you to a place where your hearts are filled with love and optimism. These songs are timeless—just like the messages woven into the soul of the music.






